RULES

1. The organisers and landowners do not accept any liability for any damage, accident, injury or illness to horse, owners, riders, spectators or their property whatsoever. Entries accepted only on this condition.
2. Hard hats with chinstraps secured must be worn at all times when mounted, hard hats must conform to latest BSJA regulations.
3. Jackets must be worn in jumping classes and back protectors are recommended.
4. Jumping classes in the main ring will be run under BS rules.
5. The judges decision is final.
6. No horse/pony under 4 years may be ridden.
7. All dogs must be kept on leads.
8. No whip or spurs allowed in the gymkhana classes.
9. No illegal assistance by spectators is allowed.
10. Age as on day of show.
11. Cups points are awarded separately for each pony in each section of the gymkhana.
12. Competitors may be disqualified for excessive use of the whip
13. Any objection must be made immediately with a deposit of £20, which will only be refunded if the objection is upheld. The objection must be from a competitor in the same class.
14. All cups and trophies must be signed for and returned to the Show Secretary in good order for the following year.
15. Competitors entering classes which may clash do so at their own risk, although every effort will be made to minimise the clashing of classes.
16. It is the responsibility of the competitor to make themselves aware of the progress in each ring and inform the ring steward of that ring if they are held up elsewhere. Otherwise no class will be held up for late entries.
17. Organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes according to entries.
18. Trophies are presented to the 'Best Local Rider'. The area will be defined as on the map at the Secretary's tent and Rider's permanent address is within this defined area.
19. Local trophies are awarded to the 'Best Local Rider' other than the First Prize Winner, or at the Organisers discretion.
20. NO stallions are permitted on the showground.
